We the legatees under the will of Peter Burr deceased and William Lyne Junr. Assignee of Peter Burr being of lawful age do by these presents consent to abide by the division of the said Peter Burr decd. Land as made by Christopher Collins and others agreeable to the boundaries now held by us respectively. Witness our hands and seals this 4th day of February 1804 [page 523]
